The Safety and Security Sector Education Training Authority (SASSETA) invites Government and Private Employers whose core business falls within its sector to provide a list of their training needs for the financial year 01 April 2019 to 31 March 2020. The following categories of interventions will be considered by SASSETA, the total number of people that can be supported for the sector is included in brackets is included to assist planning:

- Learnerships for Workers (2,100)
- Learnerships for Unemployed persons (2,100)
- Skills Programmes for Workers (3,150)
- Skills Programmes for Unemployed persons (2,620)
- Bursaries for Workers (210)
- Artisans (150)
- Internships (450)
- TVET Student Placements (500)
- University Placements (220)
- Candidacy (60)

As part of the SASSETA Public TVET Development program, SASSETA further invites Public TVET Colleges to nominate skills programmes for the development of their lecturers.

Applicants are requested to follow the instructions below:

2. Print the completed form and signed off by a duly authorised signatory.
3. Scan signed form and e-mail it to DG@SASSETA.ORG.ZA and attach the electronic / soft copy on Excel to the e-mail
4. Provide the correct and full qualification / programme / trade names with the NQF Level and avoid using words such as "Various", "Miscellaneous" or "TBA"
5. Provide actual numbers required, informed by a needs analysis / confirmed demand

Closing Date: 07 December 2018, at 16h00.

Please note that this is not an application for funding, but a process for SASSETA to understand and quantify the training / skills needs in its sector prior to opening of a funding window where applications will be invited against pre-approved programmes resulting from this Expression of Interest. All levy paying and exempt employers (not private Training Providers / Institutions) in the Safety & Security sector are encouraged to complete the form attached to assist SASSETA to plan accordingly.
