

DISCRETIONARY GRANT – 2ND CLOSED FUNDING WINDOW 2023/2024

The Safety and Security Sector Education and Training Authority (SASSETA) invites all Private Security Employers, (Registered under SASSETA and paying skills development levies to SASSETA or being exempt from skills development levies) who have submitted Workplace Skills Plans and had such WSP's accepted by SASSETA for the 2023/24 financial year, to submit applications for Discretionary Grants closed Funding Window for the 2023/2024 financial year.

FUNDING WINDOW

The funding window will be open to receive applications from the **18**th **of March 2024** and will close at 23:59:59 (midnight) on the **20**th **of March 2024**. Only electronic applications submitted on the portal https://indicium.sasseta.org.za/Account/Login.aspx will be considered.

No late applications will be considered.

FUNDING MODEL

Please refer to the Discretionary Grant Policy v11 Funding Framework (published alongside this advert) for guidelines on the amounts per learner per programme. SASSETA will only approve applications according to the limits stated in the policy.

DUE DILIGENCE

Applicants are advised that SASSETA may be conducting Due Diligence on short-listed applicants and further documents will need to be available during this process. Please refer to the Guidelines for a list of the documents that must be made available and must be valid at the time of due diligence.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT WITH APPLICATION

- 1. Company registrations documents (CIPC or other relevant documents) for the Employers (the Applicant)
- 2. Company registrations documents (CIPC or other relevant documents) for preferred provider/s (to be uploaded as "Other" or together with the Employer CIPC).
- 3. Valid **PSIRA** registration for Private Security Employers (Applicants).
- 4. Valid **PSIRA** registration for private security preferred training provider/s.
- 5. Valid COID Certificate or Public Liability insurance for applicant (Employer) **OR** training provider.
- Proof of accreditation and program approval letters of all training provider/s for all learning programmes to be clearly marked for the programmes applied for and scanned as one document and uploaded. Reports from SETA IT systems will <u>not</u> be accepted.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

The following documents need not be attached to the application, however, should be readily available during due diligence visit.

- A copy of a valid Tax clearance certificate / certificate of good standing issued by SARS with a valid One-Time PIN.
- 2. BBBEE Certificates/Sworn Affidavits, certification stamp not older than 6 months from the date they were certified. The affidavit(s) must be duly commissioned.
- 3. Delegation of authority / resolution for person applying on behalf of the applicant indicating that they are duly authorized to act on behalf of the applicant.
- 4. Recently printed Company registrations documents (CIPC) for the applicant printed within the last 3 months, indicating that the applicant status is "In Business".
- 5. Proof of Assessor Registration, with each unit standard clearly marked for ease of reference.
- 6. Proof of Moderator Registration, with each unit standard clearly marked for ease of reference.

Late applications will be summarily disqualified without recourse.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Must comply with the SASSETA Discretionary Grant Policy Version 11 including funding limits.
- 2. The WSP/ATR for 2023/2024 should have been submitted by 30 April 2023 or if approval was obtained for extension to submit by 31 May 2023, and the WSP/ATR was duly accepted by SASSETA.
- 3. Learning programmes applied for **must** be limited to those **advertised** herein ONLY. Applications for programmes not specifically advertised herein will not be considered.

EMPLOYED LEARNER SKILLS PROGRAMMES

These are grants that are available to the invited stakeholders operating in the safety and security sector to train their own employees (proof of employment will be required prior to acceptance of learners) against any one of the Skills Programmes listed below. **Applications for Skills Programmes not listed below will not be considered.**

SUBMISSION NOTES

- 1. All applications must reach SASSETA on or before the **20**th **of March 2024** at **23:59:59 pm (midnight).** Incomplete (material information not provided) applications will be summarily disqualified without recourse.
- 2. **Only online applications** submitted through the link will be considered no hand-delivery, postal or couriering of applications.
- 3. Applicants must upload **supporting documents** required above on the application link as directed, and they must be valid at the time of uploading.
- 4. Only employers **registered with SASSETA (SETA 19)** and submitted their WSP/ATR by may apply, and they may do so only for the programmes in this advertisement.
- 5. It is important that awarded projects **commence by the 28th of March 2024**.
- 6. SASSETA will consider applications for projects that may have already started prior to the advert, provided that those programmes started on or after 01 April 2023.
- 7. A four-phase evaluation process will be used to award grants compliance checking, evaluation, adjudication and due diligence.
- 8. These grants should only be applied for by Private Security employers that wish to train their own employees, proof of such employment will be required upon registration. The number of employed learner grants applied for may not exceed the number of employed persons listed in the WSP/ATR of 2023/24.
- 9. SASSETA reserves the right to conduct due diligence on considered applicants.
- 10. SASSETA does not charge for accessing of Discretionary Grants nor should any stakeholder have to pay for any of its services other than in the form of the Skills Development Levies paid through the South African Revenue Services. If you receive any phone call, email, or physical visit by any person asking for payment to secure this award or that the outcome can be influenced in any way; or if you know or suspect any fraudulent activity, unlawful acts, or misconduct that resulted in the award of this grants, you are required to immediately report such to the SASSETA Anti-Corruption Hotline for further investigations at 0800 204 143 or SASSETA@tip-offs.com.
