RE-ADVERTISEMENT FOR MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE SAFETY AND SECURITY SECTOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING AUTHORITY (SASSETA) BOARD

SASSETA on behalf of the Minister of Higher Education Science and Technology, Dr BE Nzimande would like to inform the members of the public and the stakeholders that, the nominations for the appointment of SASSETA Board has been re-opened for nomination of candidates.

SASSETA invites applications for suitably qualified persons to serve on the SASSETA Board from 01 April 2020 to 31 March 2025. Nominated representatives from organised labour, organised employers, government departments, bargaining councils with jurisdiction in the sector, professional bodies, critical interest groups and organisations of communities that have an identifiable interest in skills development should possess knowledge, skills and competencies in the following disciplines:

- Application of corporate governance and ethics
- Skills development legislation and the National Skills Development Plan (NSDP)
- The Public Finance Management Act
- Financial management
- Education, training, skills development and human resources development; and
- Quality assurance of learning provision

Nominations must be submitted in writing and with the following details:

1. Full names and address of the person or organisation nominating candidate.
2. A curriculum vitae of the candidate which include:
 - Candidate's full name, identity number, gender, disability status and race;
 - Contact address, telephone and email address;
 - Certified copies of qualifications (certification date stamp not older than 3 months) and certified copy of ID (certification date stamp not older than 3 months);
 - Previous experience and relevant expertise, quoting dates and organisations concerned; and
 - At least two names and contact details of reference.
3. Completed nomination form.
4. Completed declaration of interest form.
5. A signed Acceptance of Nomination Letter from a candidate.

The nomination form, SASSETA Constitution and the copy of the NSDP are available on the SASSETA website: www.sasseta.org.za. Disabled people and female candidates but without excluding male candidates are encouraged to apply.
