#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Private Security companies
- Legal Firms
- Registered under SASSETA and paying skills development levies to SASSETA or being exempt from skills development levies under SETA 19)
- Must submit WSP / PIVOTAL Training Plan for 2022/23
- CBO's, NGO's, NPO's, Cooperatives and NLPE's

#### **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

- Valid Tax clearance certificate/ certificate of good standing issued by
   SARS with a one- time pin for Applicant and preferred training provider
- Valid BBBEE Certificates /Sworn Affidavits, for Applicant and preferred provider/s
- Company registrations documents (CIPC) for employers and preferred provider/s or other relevant registration documents / partnership agreements
- Skills Development Levy Number / Proof of registration for levies under SETA 19 / Proof of Exemption by SARS for the employer. (EMP 201 required at due diligence).
- Valid PSIRA registration / Fidelity Fund Certificate (FFC) as well as Legal
   Practice Council registration for Applicant

#### **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

- Valid PSIRA registration for private security preferred training provider/s
- Companies employing less than 50 employees need only submit a Pivotal Training Plan (template on the website) should they have not submitted a WSP.
- Valid COID Certificate or relevant public liability insurance for applicant OR training provider.
- Proof of accreditation and program approval letters of all training provider/s for all learning programmes. Reports from SETA IT systems will not be accepted.
- Learning programmes applied for must be limited to those advertised.

#### **COMMON APPLICATION MISTAKES**

- Not considering <u>funding limits</u> on DG Policy
- Only <u>ONE</u> BBBEE Certificate
- Invalid BBBEE Certificate / Affidavit
- Only <u>ONE</u> Tax Clearance Certificate
- Invalid Tax Clearance
- Only <u>ONE</u> CIPC / Registration documents
- CIPC documents that <u>do not reflect</u> other / trading names used on application
- No Skills Development Levy No. for Applicant

#### **COMMON APPLICATION MISTAKES**

- Only <u>ONE</u> PSIRA Certificate
- Invalid Fidelity Fund Certificate
- No WSP / No Training Plan
- No COIDA / Public Liability Insurance
- No transcript listing U/S and Programmes
- Invalid COIDA
- Business Insurance etc
- Invalid Accreditation
- Not registered with SETA 19

#### TIPS TO IMPROVE COMPLIANCE

- Applications can ONLY be made ONLINE
- Follow the User Manual line by line
- Fill in ALL the fields
- Use the advert as a checklist and tick when uploaded / complied with
- Gather ALL the documents, upload and save them onto your computer before starting application
- Highlight each and every U/S and programme on the proof of Accreditation

#### TIPS TO IMPROVE COMPLIANCE

- Double check expiry dates on ALL documents
- Each document must be valid as at 14 April
   2022
- Life happens Apply EARLY, do NOT WAIT FOR CLOSING DATE
- Be familiar with Funding Framework
- SASSETA staff cannot submit application on your behalf or amend your application
- No extensions, no chance to submit after closing date

#### DUE DILIGENCE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Assessor Registration for each unit standard and Learnership
- 2. Moderator Registration for each unit standard and Learnership
- 3. Facilitator details including CV and proof of qualifications (must have a qualification above what they are facilitating)
- 4. Proof of financial viability / liquidity such as audited financial statements / letter from auditor etc.
- 5. Proof of payment of SDL (EMP 201 + proof of payment for 6 months)
- 6. Proof of compliance with Occupational Health & Safety Regulations
- 7. Physical inspection of premises and the workspaces / tools of trade for the learners / interns
- 8. Availability of Mentors

#### **COMMON DUE DILIGENCE ISSUES**


- Ill-preparedness for due diligence assessment
- Invalid documents
- Evidence not documented and readily available
- No proof of paying levies / exemption
- Tax evasion deliberate underpayment of SDL
- Tax avoidance payroll understated to pay less SDL
- Non-Compliance to OHS requirements
- No / Limited Capacity to host
- No / Limited capacity to train
- No sites for practical training
- Unsuitable premises
